## **ABUNDANT FRUIT-BEARERS 1**

"My Father is glorified and honored by this, when you bear much fruit, and prove yourselves to be My [true] disciples." John 15:8 (NKJV)

At the eve of the arrest and death of Our Lord Jesus, He shared some heartfelt realities with His disciples. These things unveiled, the core of His intentions, His desire or burden, His tack and divine probity. We have touched on some few of them in previous episodes.

In "Remain Steadfast In Love 2", I stated explicitly that, the love of God, is not designed only for your enjoyment. This love is to become your expression.

And the goal of our Lord Jesus (to have you remain steadfast in Him) is that, you will become fruitful as He is. Before our Lord Jesus addressed the virtue of keeping His commandments, He made this profound statement:

Thus, in His death, He did not just resurrect as an individual person. Our Lord in resurrection, became a corporate being.
