### WITNESSES BY THE SPIRIT

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you: and you shall be witnesses of me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in all Samaria, and into the uttermost part of the earth" Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

EPISODE 89

The Holy Spirit did not come to indwell us for our self gratification. He came to indwell us that we shall be witnesses of Christ. When the Holy Spirit came into us at new birth, He dispensed His power into us. The Holy Spirit Himself is the embodiment of God's power. The Holy Spirit is in you with the immeasurable power of God.
