

THE SURGEON'S SCALPEL -THE WORD OF GOD

"For God's Message is full of life and power, and is keener than the sharpest two-edged sword. It pierces even to the severance of soul from spirit, and penetrates between the joints and the marrow, and it can discern the secret thoughts and purposes of the heart."

Hebrews 4:12 (Weymouth New Testament).

God takes great interest in His purpose and plan. Though Christ is the center of God's purpose and plan, man has been mingled into Christ through the regeneration of life. As man (specifically, the regenerated man in Christ) plays a key role in the fulfillment of God's eternal purpose and plan, God has taken interest in the well-being of man. God didn't place man into time to suffer. God placed man into time for the manifestation of His glory. From the revelation of scriptures, we see that all things began through God's creative work. And all that God made was good. He made all things by His creative material (The Word), backed by His creative force (the Spirit). In Genesis 3, we saw the corruptible attempt of the adversary. The adversary's initiative was focused on corrupting God's purpose and plan, by corrupting man.

However, God has always worked through these two proceeding agents to fulfilling His plan and purpose through man:

The Word and The Spirit

Without these two divine elements, no one can fulfill purpose. You need to understand that the Word of God is indispensable in the fulfillment of God's intention for you. The Word brings you into the realm of manifestation.

From previous episode, we saw the Word of God as the Sword in our mouth. Hence, the Word of God is also a brutal offensive weapon given to you by God. There are situations orchestrated by the adversary to prevent you from advancing in purpose. You don't sit to wait for that situation to overwhelm and cripple you. Engage the sword of the Spirit - which is the Word in your mouth.

Beloved this is WAR!

We also have the Word as God's elixir for our health.

Get this, in the field of medicine, there are other special methods in dealing with certain health obstruction. Some conditions require intense

surgical procedure. This is to remove an obstruction or repair diseased tissues. Surgical procedures reposition structures to their normal position. Beloved, God is not just a creator, He is also the original surgeon. Just as the Word is His creative material; He also has the Word as the surgical scalpel. The Word of God as a sword of the spirit, is not only effective in the hands of a skillful soldier of Christ. It is also operative in the hands of God and His trained teachers of the Word.

"God means what he says. What he says goes. His powerful Word is sharp as a surgeon's scalpel, cutting through everything, whether doubt or defense, laying us open to listen and obey."
Hebrews 4:12 (MSG).

When God speaks His word to you, it cuts deep as a skillful surgeon using the surgical scalpel in an operating theatre. The Word has the ability to cut through you to remove every "doubtful tissues" in your imagination and thoughts. It removes all obstructions of the adversary in your heart.

Surgeons only use the scalpel to heal or mend what is broken. That is what the Word of God does in you. It heals your diseases, mends what is broken, removes cancerous cells in your system. It is so sharp that when it pierce through you it will cut off pride, selfishness and divide thoughts which are of God (spirit) from your intellect (soul: mind, emotions and will). God as the great surgeon desires to heal us through His word. He corrects our thought patterns and give us the right mindset to fulfill His purpose and plan.
