ESTEEM THE REVELATION-LIGHT

"Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the

words of his mouth more than my necessary food. Job 23:12 (KJV)

Imagine living for an hour without breathing?

The scriptures (as the Word of God) are the outbreathings of God for our inward breathings. They are not the suggestions of God but the precepts of His wisdom. The Word embodies God's thoughts. All things were made by the Word of God.
