Your prayer of supplication must be soaked in thanksgiving.

"Be anxious for nothing, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." Philippians 4:6 (Berean Standard Bible).

Learn to spend more hours to thank the Lord, than the hours you use in making a petition to the Lord.
